

## Tools for Safe and Smart Bail System Changes: Bail Determinants

Severity	Level and seriousness of the alleged offense.
Nature and circumstances	Aggravating factors (e.g., causing an injury, using a weapon, resisting arrest).
Current supervision	Whether the defendant was on probation, parole or pretrial release at the time of the offense.
Criminal history	Defendant's criminal record, including prior arrests, convictions or jail sentences.
Court appearances	Defendant's history of complying with court dates.
Community ties and stability	Local family ties, length of residence, employment, transportation and other community connections.
Behavioral health	Past or current drug or alcohol abuse and/or severe mental health issues impacting the ability to appear in court or remain law-abiding.
Ability to pay	Defendant's financial resources may be considered (some states require).
