Virginia Pretrial Risk Assessment Instrument (VPRAI and VPRAI-R)	<ul> <li>Failure to appear</li> <li>New criminal arrests</li> <li>Technical violations</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Created 2003; updated 2009; revised 2016</li> <li>Both VPRAI and VPRAI-R: <ul> <li>Felony charge (VPRAI-R limits to felony drug, theft or fraud)</li> <li>Pending charge(s)</li> <li>Number of misdemeanors or felony convictions</li> <li>Prior failure(s) to appear</li> <li>Number of violent convictions</li> <li>Employment at time of arrest</li> <li>History of drug abuse</li> </ul> </li> <li>VPRAI only: <ul> <li>Time at current residence</li> </ul> </li> <li>VPRAI-R only: <ul> <li>Active community criminal justice supervision</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Colorado Pretrial Assessment Tool (CPAT and CPAT-R)	<ul> <li>Failure to appear</li> <li>New criminal arrests</li> </ul>	Created 2012; revised 2020 • Both CPAT and CPAT-R: - Age at first arrest - Active warrants - Pending cases - Currently on supervision - Past or current problems with alcohol (CPAT-R adds drugs) • CPAT only: - Having home or cell phone - Residence (own vs. rent) - Residential payment contribution - Past or current mental health treatment - Past jail sentence(s) - Past prison sentence(s) - Revoked bond or supervision history • CPAT-R only: - Current employment/education - Prior arrests - Arrests within past year - Prior failure(s) to appear (past year)
