Support Tool	Success in Improved Pretrial Outcomes
Court notifications	 Several studies have shown this tool can significantly reduce failures to appear Other considerations for improved efficacy: Live, in-person phone calls (vs. text or email) Include information about repercussions of missed court dates Include information on how to plan for an upcoming hearing
Behavioral health support	 Drug/alcohol testing - No clear association; may be higher efficacy when testing is coupled with treatment Drug/alcohol treatment - No clear association Mental health treatment - Limited research exists; anecdotal research shows some success
Basic needs support	 Transportation/child care - Limited research exists; some organizations have anecdotal evidence supporting success Public benefits - Limited research exists; some programs show promising results Housing - Limited research exists; some programs show promising results
Pretrial supervision	 Case management/check-ins - Outcomes are mixed; may slightly improve pretrial outcomes (particularly failures to appear) Outcomes may vary based on type and frequency of supervision Some research indicates supervision for low-risk defendants could be counterproductive Electronic monitoring - Outcomes are mixed; may successfully lower flight risk and rearrests, but can result in more technical violations
